Doors and Enemies - Part II

James 1:2-4 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ³ because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. ⁴ Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything

We live with the tension between two spiritual worlds: the kingdom of God and the kingdom of Satan. Each kingdom needs people to achieve their perspective goals.

Matthew 13:24-27Malachi 3:10

Why will God pour out a blessing to those who tithe? God always responds to obedience. God blesses so we will be a blessing.

Matthew 16:13-33

Peter has a revelation, and Jesus proclaims a blessing on him. Peter then becomes a stumbling block, and tries to stop Jesus from His assignment.

IDENTIFY YOUR ENEMY

Matthew 5:44-45a But I say unto you, love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; ⁴⁵ That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven.

Speak to the spirit behind the person. We do not wrestle against flesh and blood. We always have a choice to be a vessel that God can pour into, or a stumbling block for God's plan.

CHRONOS OR KAIROS

In the beginning, God created time. Time has a beginning and an end, but God is eternal. God is the Alpha and Omega, the author and finisher. All time fits into the eternal God.

Chronos is sequential time, minute by minute. We live in Chronos time; God lives beyond time. Kairos is an appointed time for God's purposes, a strategic time when God sends something planned in eternity to invade our Chronos, or sequential time. Kairos are moments that must be seized, when heaven's time invades earth for a greater purpose.

You can have many Kairos times within your Chronos time. God does not guide our lives by Chronos. He guides us by Kairos
